- 2. Entry Fees \$16 per Class

- 4. Entries in the Stake/Championship Classes must have been shown and judged in their respective qualifying classes.
- 5. Post Entries will be accepted for qualifying classes at \$5.00 additional per (Qualifier) class up to one hour prior to the start of each session. Entries for Championship classes will be accepted up to one hour prior to the start of the session at no additional charge. ALL CLASSES MUST BE ENTERED 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE START OF THE SESSION.

6. Academy Under Saddle

Classes 3, 8, 11, 14, 16, 22, 29, 44, 68, 74, 81, 88
