

We could also use an extra person to help to move the jumps into place. They are heavy. The jumping classes typically start between 1:30 and 2:30 and last around 1 hour. You would not have to stay until the end as the initial setting of the jumps is when you would be most needed.


These jobs do not require knowledge of horses or of horse shows. The current group of volunteers will give guidance to the new volunteers.






