4. Reckless riding or people exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Individuals will be asked to leave the show grounds. Any refunds will be forfeited.
5. Riders showing in Leadline may show in Limit Walk, Trot/Jog Classes Only.
6. Limit classes cannot enter classes that canter. They are only open to riders who have not won six blue ribbons in classes with more than one horse.
7. 6 Ribbons awarded per class
8. Judge's decision is final
9. Show management has the right to Combine/Add/Cancel classes
10. Gaming classes are open and may be shown in English or Western tack.
11. Food will be available the day of the show.
12. All Quentin Horse Shows are eligible for point accumulation with the PSHA, APHA and SVHSA. Ask for details at the show office.
